

## **GOLF**

#### PGA Head Professional: Eric Barnes

Arrival: Drop golf bags at bag drop. Check-in with caddy master and proceed to the locker room. Change shoes and clothes in the locker room if necessary.

### Dress Code-Golf Course

Only conventional and appropriate golf attire may be worn. Shorts and skirts must rise no more than 4" above the knee. Mock turtlenecks are acceptable. If you have questions as types of appropriate sports attire or need to purchase any for a guest, please look at the type of clothing available in our golf pro shop. Golf shirts are required to be tucked in at all times for men, and for women when appropriate. Hats must be worn with bills squarely to the front. **Not acceptable:** Denim of any kind, short shorts, very short mini-skirts, tennis shorts, cargo pants/shorts, athletic/jogging shorts/pants, cutoff slacks, swimming attire, halter tops, fishnet tops and t-shirts are not allowed on the golf course, practice range or practice putting green.

### Dress Code-Clubhouse Locker Rooms

Members and guests are allowed to wear "dressy jeans" as acceptable attire. Hats are not allowed to be worn in the clubhouse. **Not acceptable:** Examples of non-appropriate jeans are those that are ripped, faded, tattered, cut off, frayed or have holes.

Pace of Play Please play without delay. It is the duty of every golfer to keep up with the game in front and not just ahead of the game behind. All 18-hole rounds should be played in four hours or less and all 9-hole rounds should be played in two hours or less. Golfers who play slowly should stand aside and signal faster players to play through. Golfers riding in carts should pace themselves so as not to place unreasonable pressure on walking players ahead.

#### Care of the course

- Repair ball marks in the greens
- Replace divots
- Rake bunkers
- Comply with any special rules concerning the use of carts that day
- Carts must use the rough for travel when indicated.
- Carts are never permitted within 25 feet of any green or within a restricted designated area around any green or tee.



## **Lightning detection**

For your safety, the club installed an automatic lightning detection system. When you hear one long blast of the horn, there is lightning in the area and all golfers must clear the course. Once the course is available for play, three short blasts of the horn will occur. Three tones indicate that lightning is no longer in the vicinity and players may resume play on the golf course and practice tee/range.

# TENNIS/PADDLE

Director of Racquet Sports: Dane Schmidgall

Arrival: Before entering the courts, please stop in the tennis shop or paddle hut and register. Men's and women's locker facilities are available.

#### Dress Code

Proper tennis attire is required on the courts at all times. Men must wear tennis shorts, collared shirts or mock turtlenecks and tennis shoes. Members may wear collarless tennis shirts at the tennis facilities. Women may wear tennis-appropriate tank shirts, polo shirts, tennis skirts and shorts. Appropriate dress for the paddle courts is consistent with the tennis court dress code, however, appropriate t-shirts and paddle gear are allowed at paddle. If you have questions as types of appropriate sports attire or need to purchase any for a guest, please look at the type of clothing available in our tennis pro shop. Not acceptable: Denim of any kind, running shorts and cut-offs are not allowed. No t-shirts are allowed on the tennis courts except if worn by children.

# **AQUATICS**

Aquatics Director: Bob Bruggeman

Arrival: Please register at the main entrance to the pool area. Locker facilities with showers are available. Children under 10 may use the pool only when accompanied by an adult or person 16 years or older responsible for their care and safety.

#### **Dress Code-Pool**

Dress Code Proper swim suits are required to use the pool. Casual flip flops and t-shirts may only be worn at the pool. Members and guests are allowed to wear "dressy jeans" (including denim skirts and shorts for women) as acceptable attire while at the pool. Please use the pool locker rooms to change for the pool, and to change before coming back into the clubhouse. Not acceptable: Only proper swimwear is allowed while swimming in the pool. No thong bikinis allowed. Examples of non-appropriate jeans are those that are ripped, faded, tattered, cut off, frayed or have holes.

## **CLUBHOUSE**

## Dress Code-Outside Patio Dining Area

Proper clubhouse and golf course are allowed on the patio dining area. **Not acceptable:** Swimwear and casual flip flops are not allowed on the patio. Ladies and men's dressy open-toe shoes are acceptable.

## **Smoking**

At EGC, smoking of any kind is not permitted inside any building, including within the fenced area surrounding the pool complex. Smoking areas may be designated from time to time on the Clubhouse patio area.

#### **Tipping**

Tipping is allowed for locker room staff, caddies, caddy master, bag room staff and valet service.

### **Cell Phone Policy**

The use of cellular phones is not permitted in dining areas. Cellular phones and PDA's should always be operated in vibrate or silent mode while at Evanston Golf Club. Any phone conversations that do take place should not interfere with others playing or practicing. Cellular phone usage while playing on the golf course or in the practice areas is strongly discouraged.
